NOCN Level 2 Apprenticeship

Duration: 23 months

Overview of role

A Site Carpenter will prepare and install basic building components e.g. doors, straight staircases, wall and floor units and erecting structural carpentry and roof structures on a building site or in domestic and commercial premises.

Day release at college towards your 20% off the job training, the remainder of the week will be working alongside your employer and workplace visits once every half term. A portfolio of evidence is compiled using an eportfolio against qualification units to suit the job role for site carpenter. Assessments are carried out once you have completed the training and start gateway through NOCN assessor

An end point assessment is undertaken consisting of a knowledge test (online exam), practical skills test and professional discussion supported by the portfolio of evidence

Entry requirements

5 GCSEs including English Language and Maths at Grade or 3 above. Functional Skills Maths and English Level 1. Exemptions are available for relevant GCSE Grade 4 or above
