Your child will still be having regular observations to assess their development and this will be carried out by their key person, who will be:



so please speak to them if you wish to see your child's unique stories.

Routine

There is a more structured routine for all the children in the toddler's room and all are encouraged to sit for short periods at an activity.

Sleep Time

Children are encouraged to sleep after lunch, so that they get the most out of



the day. If they fall asleep at other times, provision will be made for them within the room for a sleep. Children who do not want to sleep are provided with other activities.

Day Sheets

These are a record of what each child has done in the day – for example, sleep times, eating habits and the activities they have played.

Potty Training

When you feel your child is ready for potty training, please discuss with a member of staff and we can work together to ensure we carry on what you are doing at home.

Outings

In the toddler room, we like to go on outings which coincide with our topic and will include anything from a nature walk to a visit to the farm. All consent forms will be given to you at the time the outings are booked. Please note that when travelling in the mini bus you must provide a car seat.

A large outside play area is available where children can participate in a variety of activities. A wide range of activities are also available throughout the day indoors, including sensory play with natural materials.
